**DESCRIPTION OF AMENDMENTS/ADDENDA:**

**1. Revised Pay Items as following:**

**3. Below are questions submitted by prospective offerors and answers provided by Prince William County.**

Q1: Would you be able to provide me with information on where the current tree guards we purchased from? We would like the tree guards to match what's currently in place.

A1: Prince William County has no additional information other than what were included in the plans. The Contractor encourage to look for the suppliers that provide a similar tree guards for uniformity.

Q2: There are also a few more than 6 trees that need to be removed, we would like to remove all dead trees from the sidewalk areas.

- A2: We have increased the quantities from SIX (6) to TEN (10). See this Amendment **1. Revised Pay Item**
- Q3: We can relocate the crape myrtles to Raftelis Park, but since the trees are so large we could damage the sidewalk when removing them. Since the tree pits are also very tight, the trees would have to be dug out by hand, which cuts off a large amount of the root system. This may or may not kill the trees and it would be more expensive to do this than to just purchase 5 new trees.
- A3: Yes. New tree of comparable caliper range, type and removing existing tree can be a replacement for tree relocation
- Q4: With all of the work we are going to be doing with creating tree pits I would also like to include a section for sod on the item list, would that be possible?
- A4: Yes. Sodding can be a replacement item for seeding and mulching, and has been added to the pay items. See this Amendment **2. Added Pay Item**
- Q5: There is also one redbud not included in the plans that has died in the first section of the project, can I include this tree in the proposal as well?
- A5: We have increased the quantity from THIRTY SEVEN (37) to THIRTY EIGHT (38). See this Amendment **1. Revised Pay Item**
- Q6: I contacted PWC sign shop about the sign, could I still get a high resolution sign image to provide to them?
- A6: Yes. An image for the River Park sign will be available upon requested. Sign Company must provide final sign quality image for sign.
